Introduction & Background

- A Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) is required under 23 CFR §450.300(a).
- LRTP provides policy goals, objectives, and strategies for the development of the MIC area multimodal transportation system for the next 25 years.
- As required under 23 CFR §450.306(b) the LRTP process shall address 10 “planning factors”.

Introduction & Background

- LRTP is developed in consultation with local jurisdictions and updated every five years.
- MIC's current LRTP, *Connections 2040* is scheduled for an update in 2019.
