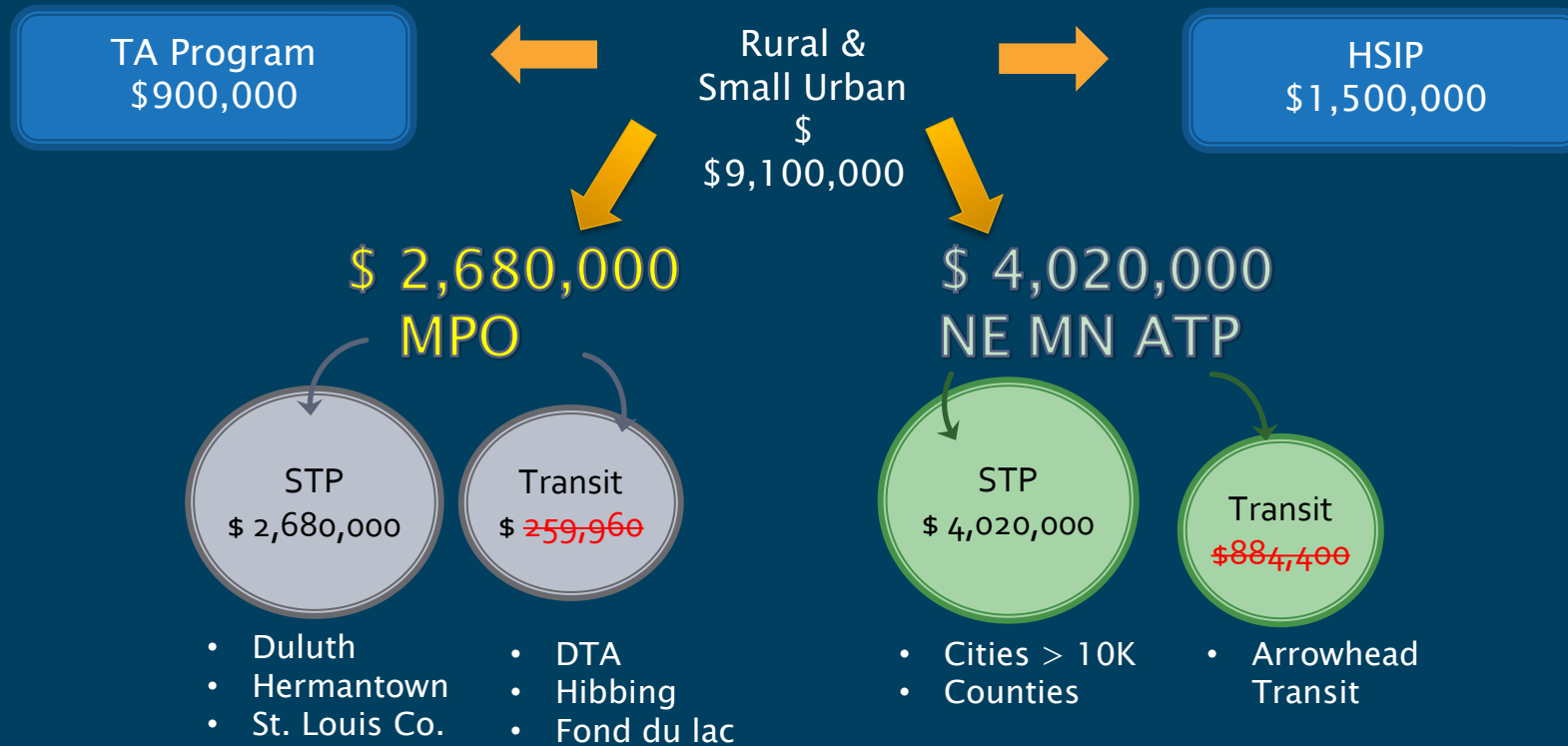
TIP 101

- Each metropolitan planning organization (MPO) is required, under 49 U.S.C. 5303(j), to develop a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)—a list of upcoming transportation projects—covering a period of at least four years.
- The TIP should include all regionally significant projects receiving FHWA or FTA funds, or for which FHWA or FTA approval is required, in addition to non-federally funded projects that are consistent with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).
- Furthermore, the TIP must be fiscally constrained.

2019-22 TIP Tentative Schedule

December 2017	• MIC sends out TIP project applications (12/4)
February 2018	• Applications due (2/5) • Staff review of applications • Distribute application packets. • Begin 1st round of public outreach.
March	• TAC & MIC Policy Board review and approval of prioritized project list • Submit prioritized list to NE MN ATP • Staff begin work on draft TIP document
April	• ATP approval of draft project list
June	• TAC & MIC approve release of draft TIP for 30 day public comment. • Begin 2nd round of public outreach.
July/August	• Continue public outreach • Make any needed minor changes to draft • TAC & MIC approve final 2019-2022 Duluth Area TIP.

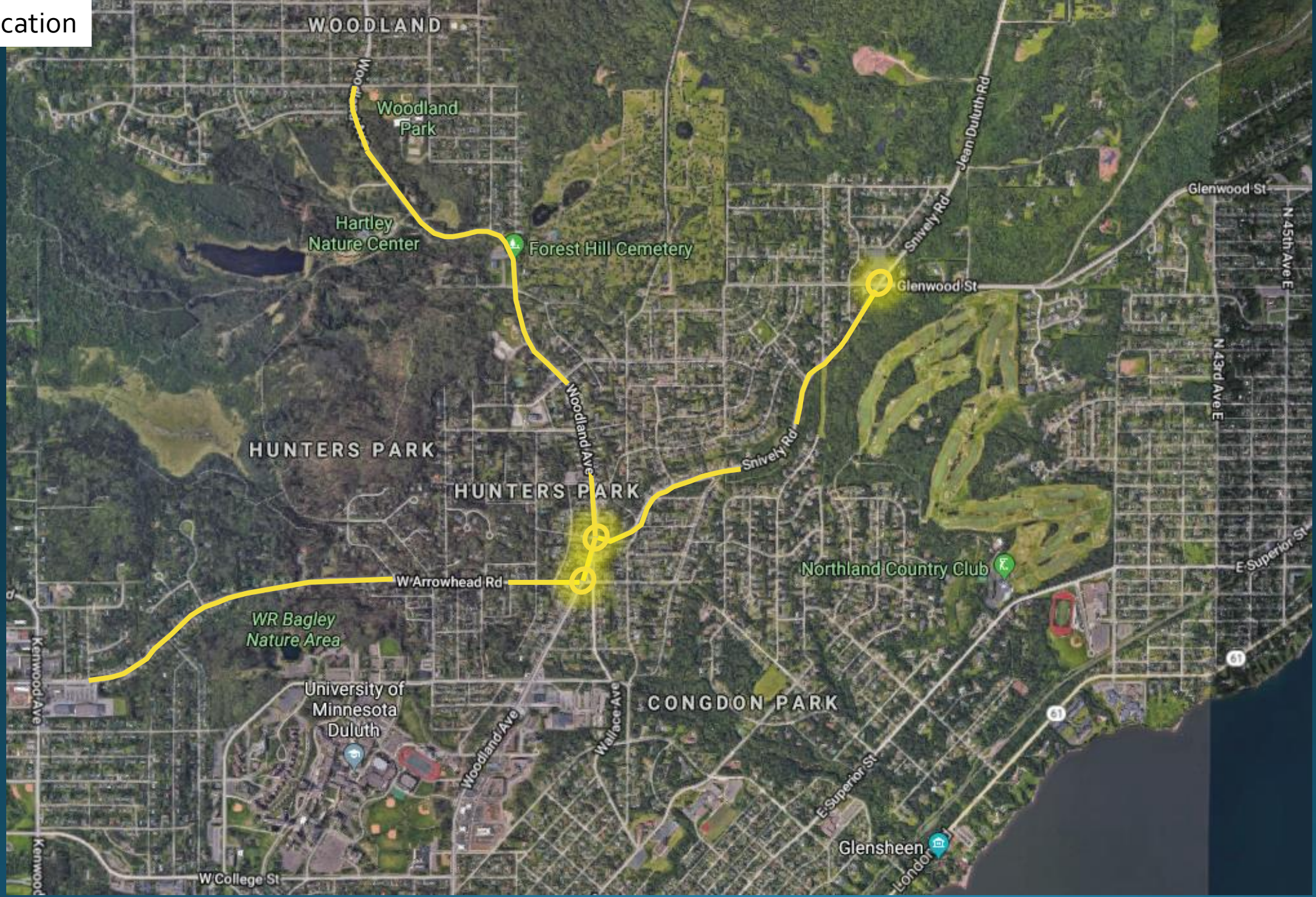

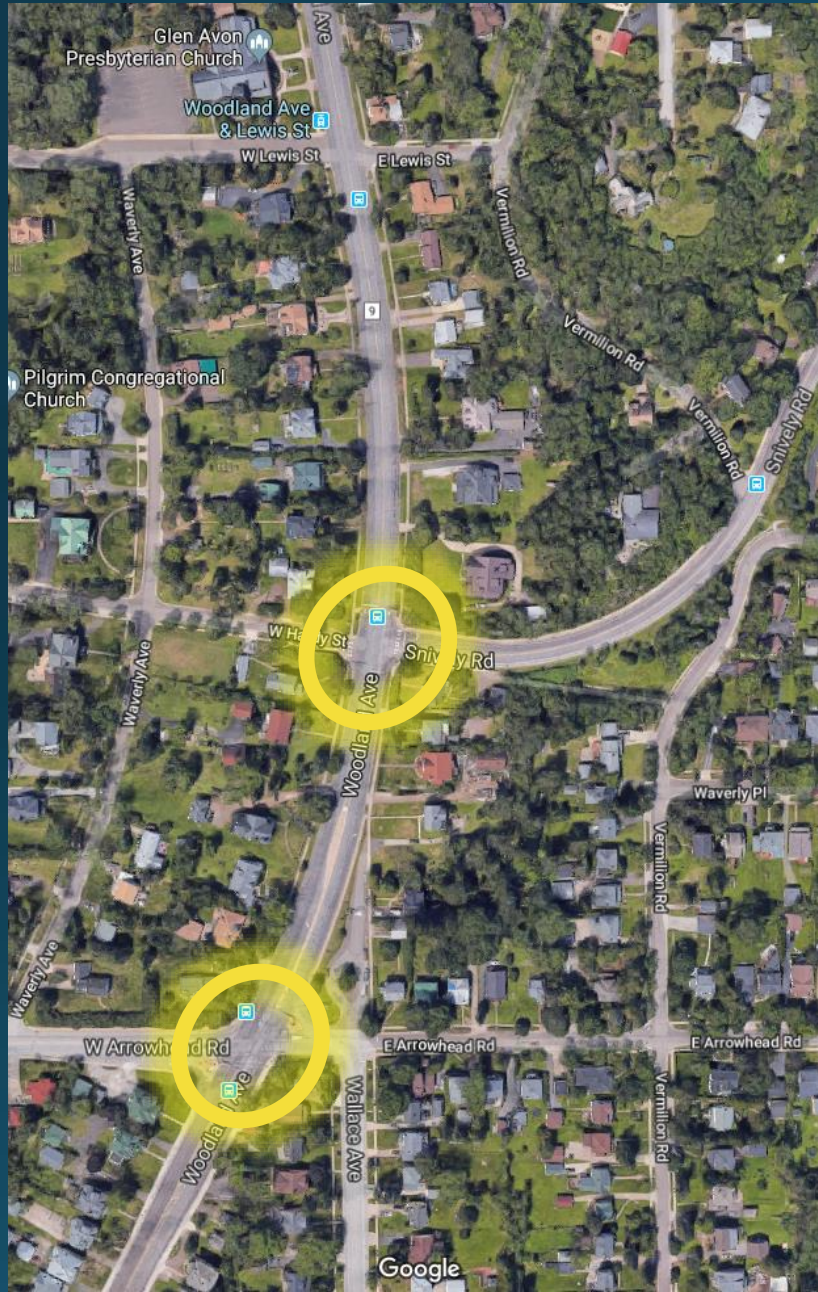
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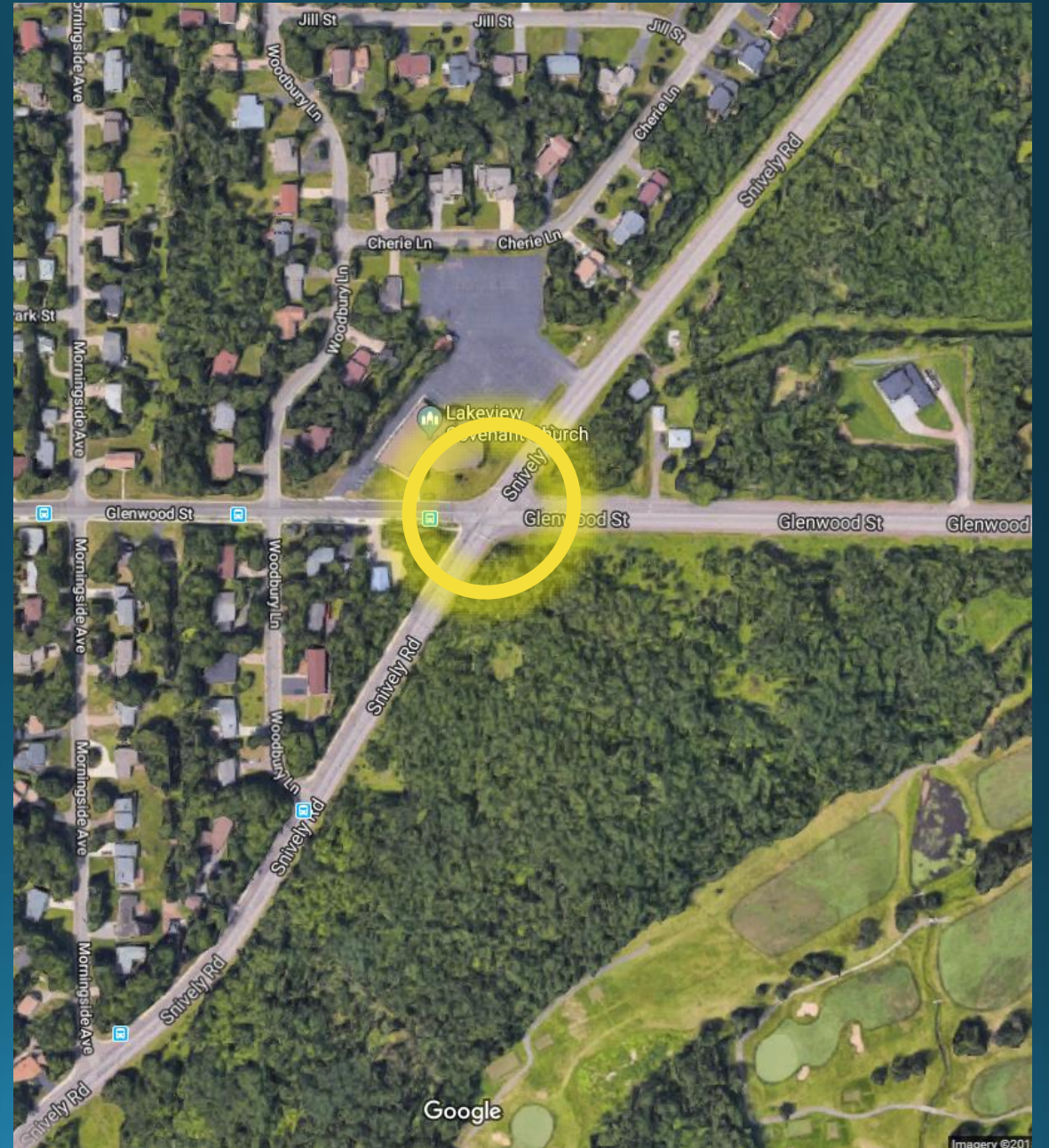
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Proposed Signal Replacement



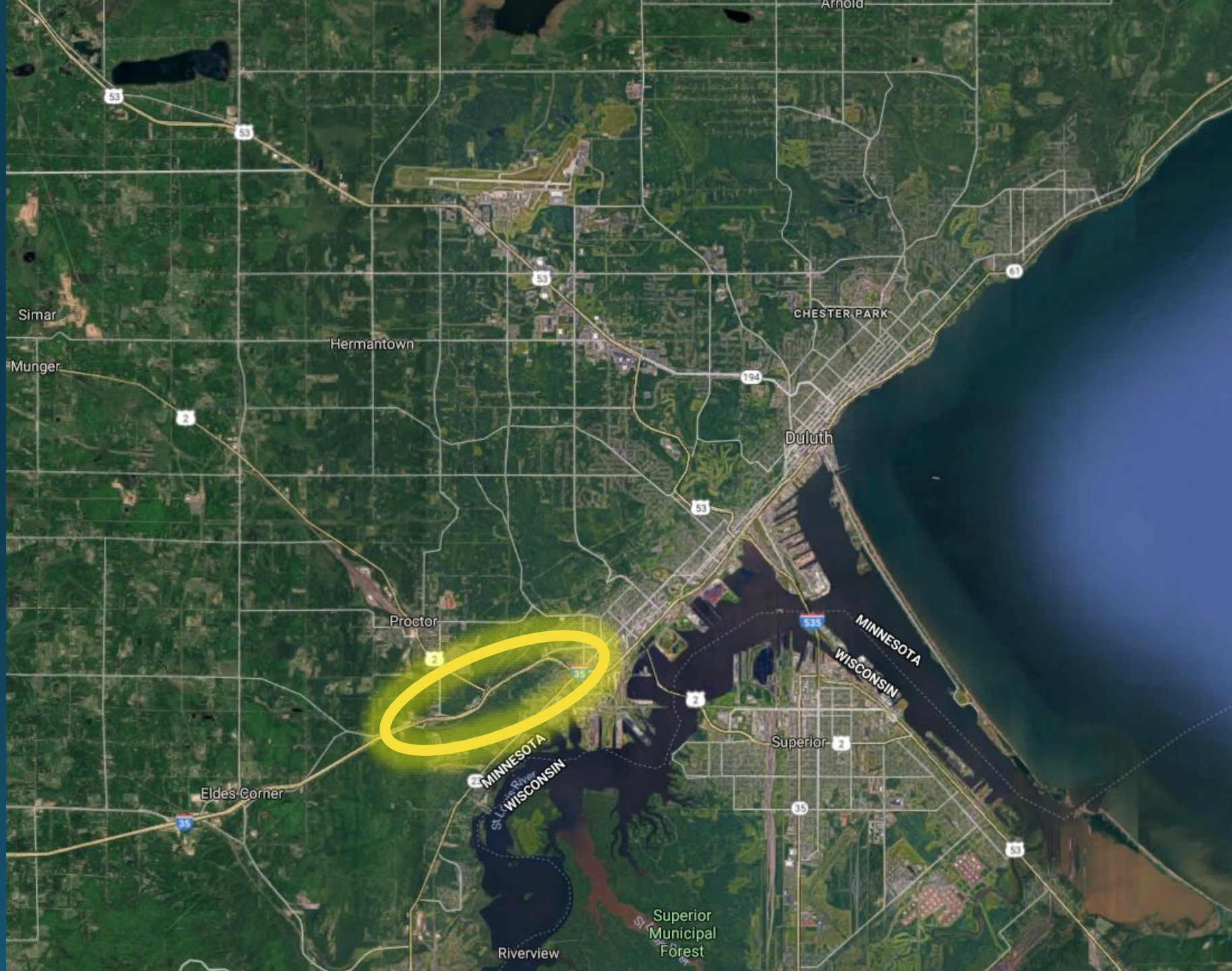
Proposed Roundabout



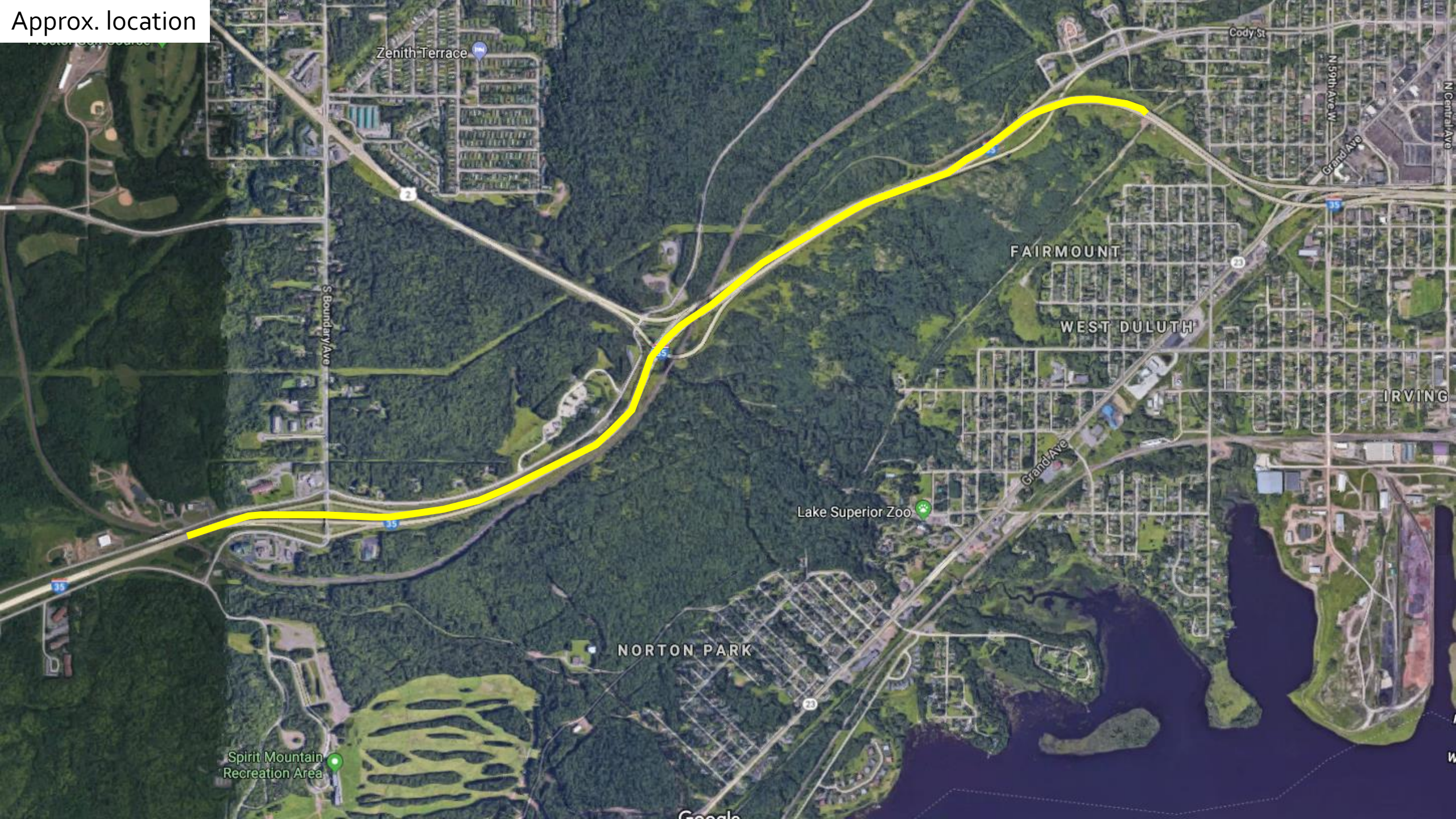
