

TIP 101




1. Each MPO is required to develop a TIP
 - list of upcoming transportation projects
2. Includes all regionally significant projects
 - Receiving or Approval of FHWA or FTA funds
 - Non-federally funded projects to ensure consistency with the LRTP
3. TIP must be fiscally constrained

<p>Solicitation December – January</p>	<p>Nov 18, 2019 – Project Application are sent out to area jurisdictions.</p> <p>Jan 3, 2020 – Project Applications DUE.</p>
<p>Prioritization January - March</p>	<p>Jan 6 – MIC staff begin review of applications.</p> <p>Jan 14/15 – TAC and MIC receive project packets.</p> <p>Jan 16 – Mar 6 – MIC public involvement activities on proposed projects.</p> <p>Mar 17 – TAC Meeting: projects are reviewed and scored.</p> <p>Mar 18 – MIC Meeting: Reviews scoring and approves final rankings.</p> <p>Mar 19 – MIC project list and rankings are submitted to the NE MN ATP.</p>
<p>Draft TIP March- July</p>	<p>Mar 19 – MIC staff begin work on Draft 2021-2024 TIP.</p> <p>April 8 – NE MN ATP approves Draft list of projects.</p> <p>June 16/17 – TAC and MIC approve Draft TIP and release for public comment.</p> <p>June 18 - July 17 – Public comment period.</p>
<p>Final TIP Aug - October</p>	<p>Aug - Minor project changes and public comments are incorporated into Draft.</p> <p>Aug 18/19 – Final TIP is presented for Approval to TAC and MIC.</p> <p>Aug 19 – Distribution to MN/DOT, FHWA & FTA for their review and approval.</p> <p>August/September - MN/DOT, FHWA & FTA review process.</p> <p>September/October - Approval from FHWA. Final TIP is distributed to the public.</p>
