



2019-21 TRANSPORTATION BUDGET ALL FUNDS



2019 Wisconsin Act 9



State Highway System

- 11,745 miles of numbered highways
- **10% of the state's** public roadways
- Carries 60% of overall traffic load



Harbor Assistance Program

- Assists harbor communities along the Great Lakes and Mississippi maintain/improve waterborne commerce
- Dock reconstruction, mooring structure replacement, dredging, facilities to hold dredged material
- \$45 M in new funding
- Since 1980: 114 HAP grants totaling over \$147 million
 - 2018 - Town of La Pointe, \$1.3M, dock widening
 - 2017 - Superior, \$1.7M, dock wall rehabilitation
 - 2017 - Washburn, \$1.3M wall reconstruction

NEW SOO LOCK PROPOSED PROJECT CONDITION



New lock will have **same dimensions** as existing Poe Lock
(1200 ft. length by 110 ft. width and a depth of 32 ft.)

Legislative Authority

- WRDA 1986 – Authorization to construct a **REDUNDANT** Poe-sized lock (1200' x 110')
- WRDA 2007 – Authorization updated to **FULL FEDERAL COST**
- WRDA 2018 – Authorization updated **TOTAL PROJECT COST** to \$922 million
