






4. Which of these options would make it easier, safer, and more comfortable for you to walk ALONG roadways in the Duluth-Superior area? Please choose up to THREE:


5. Which of these improvements would make it easier, safer, and more comfortable for you to walk ACROSS roadways in the Duluth-Superior area? Please choose up to THREE:

▼ Clearing snow on sidewalks	61.56% 386
▼ Maintaining sidewalks in good condition	54.39% 341
▼ Prioritizing the needs of pedestrians in street design	34.61% 217
▼ Keeping sidewalks clear of obstacles	34.45% 216
▼ Including vegetation (e.g. streets trees, rain gardens) between the sidewalk and the street	22.65% 142
▼ Investing more dollars in making pedestrian improvements	19.46% 122
▼ Including pedestrian connections to developments	15.79% 99
▼ Implementing stand-alone pedestrian projects, not just an add-on to roadway project	14.99% 94


